
New Business:

Crystal Alvarado introduced the new Administrative Assistant and TPS, Teri Long.

Cam Shipp, RS stated the Cooperative Agreement between the Department of Public Health/Human services and Valley County Board of Health that comes up yearly is due for January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019. The agreement establishes payment to the county Board of Health for inspections of licensed establishments and identifies which optional programs the County Board of Health will conduct. By signing the agreement, the County will receive 92-100% or 100% of funding for inspections. Responsibility of the Board of Health participant within the agreement to inspect Wholesale/Resale foods, campgrounds, trailer courts and public areas. The Board of Health also agrees to the following activities with either a Yes/No.

- Pool, spas and all water features Board of Health will not do the inspections. No was marked
- Body Art and Piercing inspections, Yes was marked
- Body Art plan establishment review-No was marked.
- Peer-Peer Inspection training -No was marked

It was put to vote for the Cooperative Agreement between the Department of Public Health/Human Services to be signed. Motion made and Dr. Millard second and all in favor to sign the agreement. It was carried.
