- Chemical inventory will need to be done before the November meeting.
- Fogging, larvicide treatment, and vehicle maintenance are being performed.
- Everything is winterized for now except the fogger. Spraying has been the northside one night and southside the next as needed and weather allows.
- Brake replacement has begun on the 2007 F150 Truck #4.
- An estimate for trades of Truck #4 was received from Hi-Line Ford and Glasgow Auto Sales.
- GPS system for the fogging system must be updated due to the current software being outdated.
 Levi will meet with the system coordinators at the meeting in Whitefish.
- Byron is working on getting his pesticide licenses to be able to be fully certified and receive credits in Whitefish.
- Levi and Byron will attend the Northwest Mosquito and Vector Control Association Annual Meeting in Whitefish. They hope to gather information on many topics including West Nile Virus and GPS systems.
- Mark & Dalton are still employed and are following the county mowers. The County Road Department is covering expenses for this.

Expense Budget vs actual was reviewed with no concerns at this time.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Motion by Jim authorizing Levi and Byron to pick up the best pick and purchase using budgeted dollars. Seconded by Jack. Motion passed. The 2007 F150 would be put out to bid at some point in time.
- Motion by Jack to put \$20,000 into the capital improvement fund. Seconded by Jim. Motion carried. That would bring the capital improvement fund up to \$70,000.

Paul stated that Chaz Zimdars still plans on doing the roofing at the Weed Shop this fall. Levi stated the wiring project still needs to be done at the Weed Shop. Mosquito will help with a portion of this expense.

Motion by Jack to adjourn the meeting. Second by Neil. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned 4:58 p.m.
