#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Leta inquired about funds from the Local Assistance Tribal Consistency fund (LATC) from Paul and there was discussion about having someone come and assess the roof life and possibly get an estimate for a new roof. The drainpipe on the corner of the building is not getting the water to the drainage area, therefore the water is running down the side of the building and leaking in the doorway. Comments were made about keeping the snow away from this area, Jolene and Ron have been doing a good job of that this winter. Dave R. said that when we meet about the roof he will look at this as well and see if there is a solution.
