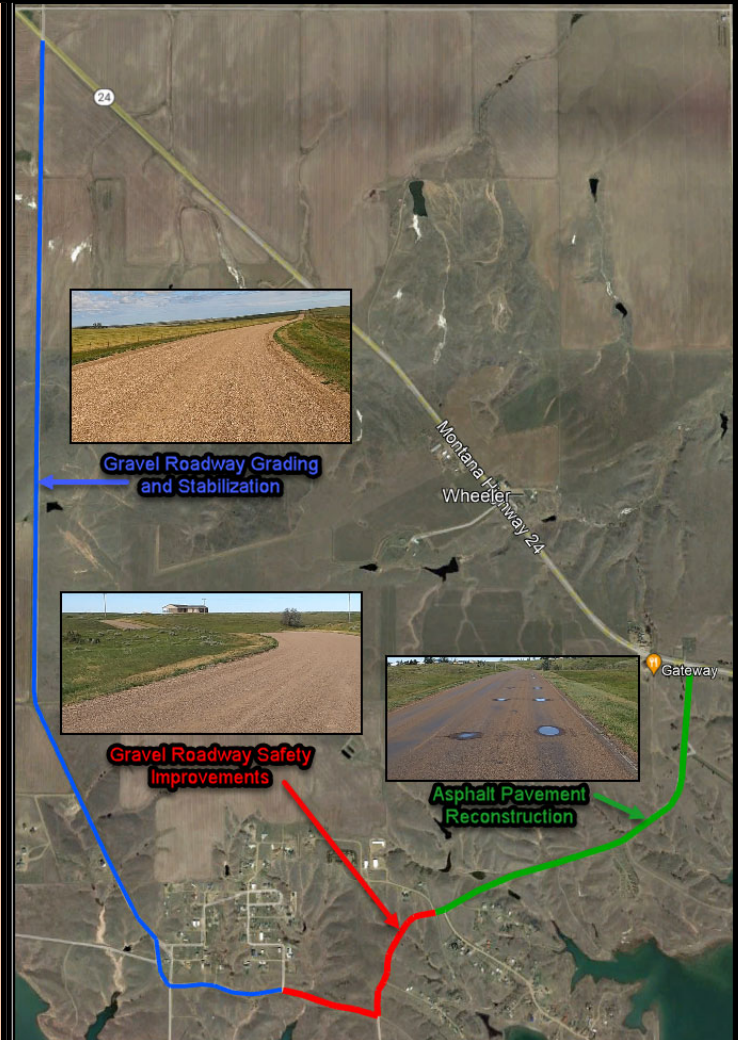
Project Information

The Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration, in partnership with Valley County and US Army Corps of Engineers, is planning to renew the driving surface of the Duck Creek Road.

Duck Road is a loop road located off of Montana Highway 24 approximately 2 miles west of Fort Peck Montana. The loop road is approximately 4.8 miles long. It provides public access to Fort Peck Marina, Duck Creek Recreation Area, local campsites and the greater Charles M. Russell Wildlife Refuge. It is also a local collector for residence in the area.

The proposed actions of the project is to:

- Reconstruct the existing 1.1 mile asphalt pavement segment with a consistent 28' paved surface.
- Reduce snow drifting and increase vertical sight distance by upgrading 0.6 mile of gravel roadway.
- Recondition and stabilize 3.1 miles of gravel roadway to reduce dust and migration of surface aggregate.
- Repair existing roadway drainage.
- Maintain a 30' surface width on the gravel roadway.
