Teri Meche - MTUPP

MTUPP has recently changed Teri’s title from Tobacco Prevention Specialist to Tobacco Education Specialist. With the new quarter coming, Teri is planning the new deliverables with schools and the public. Vaping is a major focus with the new deliverables and Glasgow has recently seen the opening of the first vape shop. By July 31, 2022, convenience stores will need to remove many of their products that don’t meet the state’s law. There is also a new focus on the effects of mental health where tobacco is concerned. Teri will be reaching out to younger groups of kids than previously; the focus is now on 4th and 5th grade. The VCHD reached out again to art classes and teachers to get students to compete in our bench art contest with a tobacco prevention theme. Only one school elected to participate, two students from Frazier provided beautiful artwork that will be featured this fall on the bench and in the Courier and Buzz recognizing these students. Lynn added that MTUPP deliverables recommend that the local city or county government look at their laws and ordinances related to vaping, Wes requested the vaping information, it was decided that Teri will send out a packet of information to all board members.
