NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion was held regarding the landfill meeting being held at the landfill. The only time it's a problem having meetings at the landfill is when it is muddy outside. Spring through fall wouldn't be a bad time to be at the landfill to have meetings and maybe even take a yearly tour of the landfill.

John Fahlgren moved to hold the meeting at the Valley County Refuse District #1 landfill May through October starting next month. Glenn Guenther seconded the motion. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Discussion was held regarding shredding tires at the landfill. Landfill Manager Brian Austin informed the board the tire shredder from Rhett Albers (from South Dakota) arrived at the landfill about two weeks ago. An excavator was rented for the tire shredder from Havre Rental because Glasgow Rental did not have one. The excavator for a week's rental is \$1,600.00. The tire shredder has been broken down since it arrived. No tires have been shredded to date. The landfill has a \$1,600.00 bill for the excavator. Landfill Manager Brian Austin asked the Valley County Refuse District #1 Board what they would like him to do, he has never run into this problem with Rhett Albers before.

Jon Kliewer moved to notify Rhett Albers he will have to supply his own excavator when the tire shredder is repaired. Glenn Guenther seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on committee update for bylaws.

Jon Kliewer moved to table the committee update on bylaws until the committee has met. Dan Carney seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jon Kliewer moved to talk about creating revenue. Dan Carney seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on trying to close the three containers in Glasgow during working hours. Landfill Manager Brian Austin feels there would need to be a gate attendant if containers were to be closed.

Glenn Guenther moved to table the discussion on creating revenue and closing containers in Glasgow until the next meeting. Jon Kliewer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the NorVal quote to run electricity to the location where the new compactor shop will be. The quote that was given for \$9096.00 expired on June 10, 2019.

Glenn Guenther moved to get an updated quote from NorVal for the next meeting. Jon Kliewer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on employee raises for the fiscal year 2019/2020. The county employees are receiving a 2.4% raise.

John Fahlgren moved to give Valley County Refuse District #1 employees a 2.4% raise on wages. Dan Carney seconded the motion. Motion carried.
