#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Erica and John Bengochea have asked for a refuse fee exclusion on 614 4<sup>th</sup> Ave South, Glasgow, MT. Secretary Schindler informed the board of the policy exclusion she has been working on. When the policy exclusion was emailed to County Attorney Dylan Jensen to look over, he sent an email back informing there should be no exclusion given on refuse fees under new statues written in 2009.

Myron Redfield moved to table the exclusion until the Refuse Board has time to investigate this matter. Ky Idler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Tim Birk has asked to have his refuse fee assessment dropped from 3 units to 2 units. A unit is a \$145.00 refuse fee. Mr. Birk owns the USDA building located at 3390 Hwy 2 East, Suite 2. The office building has locations for two rentals and one rental has left. Mr. Birk currently is not renting out the location.

Jon Kliewer moved motion to drop Tim Birks refuse assessment fee from 3 units to 2 units. Ky Idler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the credit card limit. As of now the Visa limit is \$2,500. There are some yearly bills that come in and are over the limit. Secretary Schindler has been using the Valley County Commissioner's card when this happens. The credit card is being used more and more all the time. The Refuse Board asked what the procedure would be to do this. Commissioner Tweten informed the Board, the commissioners would need to write a letter to Independence Bank to get the limit increased.

Rod Karst moved to increase the credit card limit to \$5,000. Myron Redfield seconded the motion. Motion carried
